## CONTESTANT RULES:

- Each contestant must bring:
  - A minimum of 5 gallons of finished chili.
  - A crock-pot or sterno must be used to keep it hot (no gas burners allowed).
  - Contestants must bring electrical cords, power strip, three prong outlet adapter (if needed),
  - Tablecloth and table decorations, ladle and spoon for service, and any other competition needs.
- The river fronts' activities will be at The Historic Catskill Point in Catskill (for the Greene side) and the Hudson River Front Park (for the Columbia side.)
- Contestants should arrive no later than 9:30 a.m. and be set up by 10:30 a.m. The tasting will start at 11 a.m. and continue until 4:30 p.m. The awards will be announced at that time.
- All contestants will be responsible for their site clean-up. No early departures will be allowed.
- Chili will be judged as the Best Overall Tasting and all decisions are final.
- The event will provide an 8' table (2 teams per table), chairs, tent, electricity, a name card, spoons, water, napkins, and service bowls.
